

HLTAID009 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation

Course Description:	<p>This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) Guidelines.</p> <p>This unit applies to all workers who may be required to provide CPR, in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings.</p>
Entry Requirements:	<p>Must be at least 16 years old.</p> <p>Physical fitness to perform 2 minutes of uninterrupted CPR on an adult manikin on the floor and 2 minutes of uninterrupted CPR on an infant manikin on a firm surface.</p>
Pre-Requisite:	N/A
Duration:	4 hours (1 day)
Venue:	On-Site training. To be confirmed during the booking process
Participants:	No maximum number (minimum 10 people)
Food/Beverages:	To be provided onsite by the client
Site Requirements:	Client will need to provide an area large enough, where practical CPR activities can be performed on manikins
Material Supplied:	All required material is supplied by MBE training.
Assessment:	Trainees will undertake a theory assessment, followed by a practical assessment.
Outcome:	Once competence is achieved, trainees will receive a Statement of Attainment for HLTAID009 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation
Language, literacy and numeracy:	The assessment process is broken into two sections – Knowledge and Practical. The exam is an open book test.
Other information:	Attendees will be required to perform 2 minutes of uninterrupted single rescue CPR on an adult manikin on the floor and 2 minutes of uninterrupted single rescue CPR on an infant manikin on a firm surface.
Cost:	<p>\$65 per person</p> <p>Travel + (gst) will be charged at \$1.00 per km if more than 50km from MBE office. (GST is not charged on nationally recognised training)</p>
