

RIIWH205E – Control traffic with a stop slow bat

Course Description:	<p>This unit describes a participant's skills and knowledge required to control traffic with stop-slow bat in the Resources and Infrastructure Industries.</p> <p>This unit is appropriate for those working in operational roles.</p> <p>Licensing, legislative, regulatory and certification requirements that apply to this unit can vary between states, territories, and Industry sectors. Relevant information must be sourced prior to application of the unit.</p>
Entry Requirements:	Must be at least 16 years old.
Pre-Requisite:	N/A
Duration:	8 hours (1 day)
Venue:	On-Site training. To be confirmed during the booking process
Participants:	No maximum number (minimum 4 people)
Food/Beverages:	To be provided onsite by the client
Site Requirements:	<p>Client will need to provide a roadway where signage can be set up to be used as a practical assessment.</p> <p>PPE to be work as per site requirements – Suggested minimum - Hi visibility vest/clothing, hard hat and safety boots, glasses.</p>
Material Supplied:	All required training material is supplied by MBE training. The use of site equipment is recommended to give the trainees some familiarisation with the equipment available onsite.
Assessment:	Trainees will undertake a theory assessment, followed by a JSA, and a practical assessment.
Outcome:	Once competence is achieved, trainees will receive a Statement of Attainment for RIIWH205 – control traffic with a stop slow bat as well as a wallet card with the trainee's photo
Language, literacy and numeracy:	The assessment process is broken into two sections – Knowledge and Practical. The exam is an open book and if required verbal assessments can be undertaken.

Other information:

The training and assessment will setting up signage and controlling traffic with a stop slow bat. Trainees will need to have the basic fitness required to undertake these practical tasks.

Be advised if you are required to install signage you will also need to undertake the RIIWHS302E Implement traffic management plans training course.

Cost:

\$250 per person.
